#### What can you put in the bag?



## Denors give through us ... to us

Changing lives through many ministries..

**Feedin' Them Hope:** Our building provides sanctuary from the struggles of street life; individuals can stop in, warm up, get a cup of coffee & access the services we offer. We know their stories, their names & they know here, they matter!

Our **PIN (People In Need) Bank** sees an average of 50 people per day, with more than 500 unique clients.

We support between 120 and 150 clients in our Trusteeship program.

We offer Foot Fridays & Care Cuts, programs that offer care at no charge, to anyone.

Our **Outreach** team works on the street. In January 2023, we referred 13 individuals into treatment programs & as of June, 11 of those individuals were still sober.

Our **RePurpose Donation Centre** assists more than 20 families per week by offering them household goods at no charge.

Our **Food Bank** provides hampers to those who need a little extra help. We distribute approx. 50 individual food hampers & 20 family food hampers weekly.

Our **Freedom Church** offers a safe, welcoming environment for those looking to strengthen their connection with God. Everyone is welcome!

We also offer two Life Recovery Programs: Exodus for Men & Genesis for Women. These programs see more than 30 applications per month. In 2022, we helped 33 women and 77 men reclaim their lives & achieve more than 120 days sobriety!
