# Coming Home Frequently Asked Questions

#### Q: Why are you moving?

A: We have outgrown our current space. In 2024, we served over 2,000 people and ran 7 programs from our downtown building. The new building increases our square footage, allowing us to run 9 programs from one location and bring hope to even more hearts.

#### Q: Where is the new building?

A: The new building is at 711 2A Ave N Lethbridge. That is directly across from the Soup Kitchen and Shelter. We are excited to bring light to the darkest part of our city through this new building.

#### Q: When are you moving?

A: We have purchased the building and begun renovations. We hope to move and begin services by the end of 2025.

#### Q: Is the downtown location closing?

A: Yes, but not immediately. Once the new building is ready, we will be moving all the services from our downtown (323 4th St S) location to this new building.

#### Q: Is your new building a shelter?

A: No. We will provide our services during the day, and our property will be securely closed overnight.
