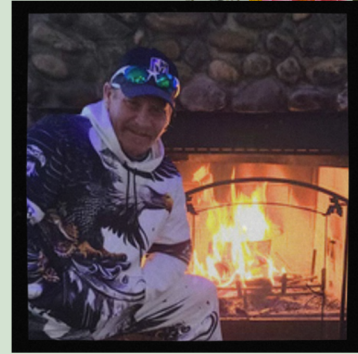

These testimonies were collected in May 2026.

### Terry

After 25 years of recovery, Terry experienced a slip and learned that recovery would be ongoing throughout his life. Following an intense assault, he entered detox and surrendered his life to Christ. Now several years later with homelessness left in his past, he is finding healing from past trauma and lives with purpose, bringing hope and encouragement to others as part of the Exodus Men's Recovery staff team.



### Tara



After years of addiction and 12 treatment attempts, Tara came to Streets Alive Mission searching for a deeper relationship with God. Now seven months sober, she is finding healing, community, and freedom from the dark void she carried in her heart for years. Today, she is experiencing a new life filled with hope and wants to complete a full year in the Genesis Life Recovery Program.

### Kyle

After over a decade of addiction, homelessness, and time in and out of jail, Kyle reached a breaking point and surrendered his life to Jesus. Now over a year sober, he is living with renewed energy, freedom, and purpose, recently regaining his driver's license and beginning to rebuild a stable, hope-filled future.
